



## Wyoming Solid Waste & Recycling Association Call for Presentations for the 2018 Annual WSWRA Conference

The Wyoming Solid Waste and Recycling Association (WSWRA) Annual Conference will be held August 20–23, 2018 in Casper, Wyoming at the Parkway Plaza Hotel and the Hogadon Ski Lodge. The WSWRA Board expects an attendance of 125 to 170 participants, including solid waste professionals from both the public and private sectors, as well as local elected officials. Interests represented include:

- waste collection;
- transfer stations;
- landfill operators and owners;
- recycling and composting operations;
- scrap recycling operations;
- solid and hazardous waste environmental regulation;
- engineering and environmental professionals; and,
- a variety of vendors.

WSWRA is seeking presentation proposals for both concurrent and general attendance sessions.

Topics of interest to WSWRA members include:

- Extended Producer Responsibility
- Recycling market updates
- Hard to Recycle programs – construction and demolition, carpet, mattresses, textiles, etc.
- Food waste composting - Collection, processing technologies, end markets, education and training
- Landfill Nature and Extent of Contamination – discussion of process, guidance or lessons from experience
- NORM/TENORM
- Waste Diversion Data Collection and Reporting
- Assessment of Corrective Measures – what is ACM, discuss the process, guidance from other states
- Trash collection and hauling – variety of topics, Pay As You Throw, Routing Systems, Automatic Vehicle Location Systems, Work Order Systems on the Cloud, Costs per Tons to Haul 20 miles to 200 miles, etc.
- Effective oral and written comments—WDEQ, W&WAB, EQC and the legislature all provide for public input—how to write effective comments
- C&D Waste: Deconstruction & separating, recycling demolition waste, cost effectiveness of C&D transport
- Overcoming political barriers to regionalization of waste handling
- Flow control—what is it and why is it important
- Transfer stations – lessons learned, alternatives, direct haul
- Any topic related to solid waste handling and permitting, including full cost accounting, budgeting, safety, personnel issues, record keeping or just about anything you can think of!
