



Wyoming Solid Waste & Recycling Association Call for Presentations for the 2019 Annual WSWRA Conference

The Wyoming Solid Waste and Recycling Association (WSWRA) Annual Conference will be held August 26-29, 2019 in Sheridan, Wyoming at the Holiday Inn. The WSWRA Board expects an attendance of 125 to 170 participants, including solid waste professionals from both the public and private sectors, as well as local elected officials. WSWRA is seeking presentation proposals for both concurrent and general attendance sessions.

 - Stormwater compliance

 - Solid Waste Transfer Station best practices and efficiency
 - Overcoming political barriers to regionalization of waste handling
